BUILDING REOPENING (PHASE 1)	May 7, 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reopen church building for all non-Sunday gatherings for <u>fully-vaccinated</u> adults** (fellowship groups, small groups, prayer meetings, etc.) • Resume children and youth programs on Fridays (children/youth may remain unvaccinated until their respective age groups are allowed by the FDA to receive vaccinations) • Continue outdoor worship services (children and youth ministries may continue to utilize the church building for activities on Sundays) • Resume third-party usage of the church building for <u>fully-vaccinated</u> adults <p><small>**Defined, per the CDC, as two weeks following the second dose of a two-dose COVID-19 vaccination (e.g., Moderna or Pfizer) or the single dose of a one-dose COVID-19 vaccination (e.g., Johnson & Johnson)</small></p>
BUILDING REOPENING (PHASE 2)	By July 4, 2021 or earlier	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reopen church building for Sunday services and Sunday School classes for <u>ALL</u> adults • Masks are required for all unvaccinated individuals 2 years and older • Resume children and youth programs on Sundays (children/youth may remain unvaccinated until their respective age groups are allowed by the FDA to receive vaccinations) • Discontinue outdoor worship services

RED ZONE	25 or more cases per 100,000 people in Harris County / City of Houston (7 day rolling average)** <small>**Calculated from this site</small>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unvaccinated adults to stay home, utilizing virtual/outdoor opportunities to remain engaged in church life (e.g., Zoom/outdoor small group meetings, Sunday home worship guides, etc.)
ORANGE ZONE	10-24 cases per 100,000 people in Harris County / City of Houston (7 day rolling average)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unvaccinated adults to stay home, utilizing virtual/outdoor opportunities to remain engaged in church life (e.g., Zoom/outdoor small group meetings, Sunday home worship guides, etc.)
YELLOW ZONE	1-9 cases per 100,000 people in Harris County / City of Houston (7 day rolling average)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Welcome unvaccinated individuals to return to activities and worship services inside the building • Resume third-party usage (including unvaccinated individuals) of the church building
GREEN ZONE	<1 case per 100,000 people in Harris County / City of Houston (7 day rolling average)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Welcome unvaccinated individuals to return to activities and worship services inside the building • Resume third-party usage (including unvaccinated individuals) of the church building <p><small>**Resumption of distributing snacks, meals, and food for various church activities (including lunch service) to be determined based on local conditions and the recommendation of the Medical Advisory Committee</small></p>
