Masks will continue to be required for all individuals ages 2 years old and older while on campus for all stages of this plan until further notice

| BUILDING REOPENING (PHASE 1) | May 7, 2021 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reopen church building for all non-Sunday gatherings for <u>fully-vaccinated adults</u>** (fellowship groups, small groups, prayer meetings, etc.) • Resume children and youth programs on Fridays (children/youth may remain unvaccinated until their respective age groups are allowed by the FDA to receive vaccinations) • Continue outdoor worship services (children and youth ministries may continue to utilize the church building for activities on Sundays) • Resume third-party usage of the church building for <u>fully-vaccinated adults</u> <p><i>**Defined, per the CDC, as two weeks following the second dose of a two-dose COVID-19 vaccination (e.g., Moderna or Pfizer) or the single dose of a one-dose COVID-19 vaccination (e.g., Johnson & Johnson)</i></p> |
| BUILDING REOPENING (PHASE 2) | By July 4, 2021 or earlier | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reopen church building for Sunday services and Sunday School classes for <u>ALL</u> adults • Masks are required for all unvaccinated individuals 2 years and older • Resume children and youth programs on Sundays (children/youth may remain unvaccinated until their respective age groups are allowed by the FDA to receive vaccinations) • Discontinue outdoor worship services |

| RED ZONE | 25 or more cases per 100,000 people in Harris County / City of Houston (7 day rolling average)** <i>**Calculated from this site</i> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recommend unvaccinated adults to stay home, utilizing virtual/outdoor opportunities to remain engaged in church life (e.g., Zoom/outdoor small group meetings, Sunday home worship guides, etc.) |
| ORANGE ZONE | 10-24 cases per 100,000 people in Harris County / City of Houston (7 day rolling average) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Welcome unvaccinated individuals to return to activities and worship services inside the building • Resume third-party usage (including unvaccinated individuals of the church building) • Face masks are required for all individuals |
| YELLOW ZONE | 1-9 cases per 100,000 people in Harris County / City of Houston (7 day rolling average) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Welcome unvaccinated individuals to return to activities and worship services inside the building • Resume third-party usage (including unvaccinated individuals) of the church building • Face mask are optional for vaccinated, but required for unvaccinated individuals ages 2 and up (unless the child is unable to remove his/her own face mask. |
| GREEN ZONE | <1 case per 100,000 people in Harris County / City of Houston (7 day rolling average) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Welcome unvaccinated individuals to return to activities and worship services inside the building • Resume third-party usage (including unvaccinated individuals) of the church building <p><i>**Resumption of distributing snacks, meals, and food for various church activities (including lunch service) to be determined based on local conditions and the recommendation of the Medical Advisory Committee</i></p> |
